WARNING OF STRAINED OPERATING CONDITION (SOC) – PACK

The EPNG system linepack starts Gas Day February 22, 2024 at 8,290 MMcf, which is an increase of 132 MMcf compared to the start of Gas Day February 21, 2024 due to actual deliveries below scheduled quantities.

Washington Ranch is currently limited to injection with one of the two units.

Delivery point operators are encouraged to continue to take gas according to their scheduled quantities. If the situation fails to improve EPNG will declare an SOC for a PACK condition.

Supply operators are encouraged to reduce and/or maintain their deliveries into the EPNG system at their scheduled rates.

Imbalance payback to the system, such as Payback (Imbalance Payback from TSP) transactions, will be denied due to operational concerns related to maintaining adequate linepack.
