WARNING OF STRAINED OPERATING CONDITION (SOC) – PACK - UPDATE #1

EPNG remains in an SOC Warning for a PACK condition (reference Critical Notice No. 620822). System linepack is currently at 8,302 MMcf which is an increase of 12 MMcf compared to the start of Gas Day February 22, 2024, concerns remain that actual deliveries below scheduled quantities will impact our ability to maintain system pressure within reasonable operational limits.

Washington Ranch is on maximum injection.

Delivery point operators are encouraged to continue to take gas according to their scheduled quantities. If the situation fails to improve EPNG will declare an SOC for a PACK condition.

Imbalance payback to the system, such as Payback (Imbalance Payback from TSP) transactions, will be denied due to operational concerns related to maintaining adequate linepack.
