### **Notice Text:**

El Paso Natural Gas (EPNG) has declared a **Strained Operating Condition (SOC)** due to high line pack conditions on El Paso.

EPNG has reduced the daily positive imbalance tolerance to 5% of scheduled quantities. **In response, Southwest Gas Corporation will reduce the positive imbalance tolerance to 5% for Arizona transportation customers.** Southwest Gas Corporation requires that transportation customers in Arizona closely monitor their nominations and scheduled quantities and match or nominate less gas than projected usage.

The tolerance stated above may be adjusted by EPNG if pipeline conditions change. Customers who create an imbalance in excess of the specified imbalance tolerance stated above may be subject to a pro rata share of any upstream pipeline charges and/or other charges that were incurred for such excess quantities.
