Subject: JEA Critical Flow Day Notification (Gas Days Jan-24, Jan-25 & Jan-26)
Importance: High

Due to the abnormally cold weather forecasted, Jackson Energy Authority (JEA) is declaring a Critical Flow Period and issuing a natural gas flow restriction starting at 9:00 a.m. on Saturday, January 24th, through 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, January 27th (gas days 24th, 25th and 26th).

A natural gas **Critical Flow Day** means you must stay within the amount of gas you have delivered to the JEA city gate for that particular day. If you are not certain of your daily nomination, please contact your gas supplier because you will be limited to use only the volume of gas they schedule and deliver on your behalf. If you do not have sufficient gas scheduled for your operations on these days, please schedule additional gas deliveries through your gas supplier or plan to curtail your operations to stay within that scheduled delivery. Overruns (excess above your scheduled delivery amount) will be invoiced as per section 3.7 of the Transportation Agreement (three times the Daily Sales Rate). This notice is being issued at this time to allow sufficient time for you to make preparations to minimize the impact on your normal operations. We also suggest you stay in close contact with your gas supplier since daily nominations are subject to change based on TGT pipeline restrictions.

This flow order is based on the current weather forecast for these days and the upcoming week. JEA will continue to monitor the weather forecast and, if weather conditions change, we will revise the restriction accordingly including extending the Critical Flow period.
