Dear Valued Customer:

This letter serves as a notice of Force Majeure event effective as of January 24, 2026, due to extreme weather conditions that have caused gas supply shortages in the geographic region applicable to your natural gas sales agreement with Symmetry. We have received notice from Superior Midstream, one of the suppliers used to satisfy your natural gas needs, that a severe winter weather event has resulted in well freeze-offs and operational issues that have significantly reduced or shut-in natural gas production.

The supply cuts, the extent of which are currently unknown, will be proportionally allocated across all impacted customers which will reduce your contract volume. If you use gas above your reduced contract volume, Symmetry may need to procure alternative natural gas supply at the then current market prices to cover your additional gas consumption. The costs Symmetry incurs to secure any such additional gas supply will be included in your invoice.

Although this event and resultant natural gas supply cuts are beyond Symmetry's reasonable control, we are diligently exploring ways to overcome or reduce the impacts of this Force Majeure event.

We appreciate your business and your cooperation as we partner with you to navigate this event, and we will continue to communicate with you as updates become available.
