### **Notice Text:**

Southwest Gas Corporation (Southwest Gas) is issuing a Stage 2 Operational Flow Order (OFO) for Southern Nevada due to high line pack conditions on Kern River Gas Transmission Company in addition to excessive packing by transportation customers. Southwest Gas requires that transportation customers in Southern Nevada closely monitor their nominations and scheduled quantities versus usage. Southwest Gas requires that the daily positive imbalance be less than or equal to 3% of scheduled quantities or 300 therms, whichever is greater, for customers who operate in accordance with Section 6.9 of Schedule No. ST-1/NT-1 of its Nevada Gas Tariff No. 7. Positive imbalance nominations during this high line pack condition will not be accepted.

The tolerance stated above may be adjusted if pipeline conditions change. Customers who create an imbalance in excess of the daily tolerance stated above will be assessed daily excess imbalance charges and may be subject to non-compliance charges.
